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'MADE IN OMAN' BUSES TO BE LAUNCHED SOON

With the production of new buses with the logo 'Made in Oman' under the trademark of Karwa, Oman is on the verge of reaching a significant milestone, said Dr. Ibrahim Ali Al Balushi, Chief Executive Officer of Karwa Motors.

He said that the company is gearing up to launch its first bus

at its Duqm plant in the Special Economic Zone-Duqm.

Speaking to the Duqm Economic Magazine, April edition which will be released this week, he said that "the company is planning to produce not less than 200 vehicles of advanced school bus type during the current phase." "The company's production would not be restricted to these types of buses only but move to produce city buses and longdistance buses," he said, adding that the production capacity in the first stage would be 500 buses annually followed by a production capacity between 500-700 buses, thereafter.



The company's Duqm plant is one of the strategic investments between the Sultanate and Qatar through the contribution of Oman Investment Authority with a share of 30 per cent and Mowasalat of Qatar by 70 per cent.

The company has made available 40 internal workstations for the manufacturing of the bus and assembly of its parts, painting and for quality inspection.

The factory includes three main workshops, which are the cutting and welding unit, dyeing workshop, and the equipment and motors assembly sections.

When the engineers confirm that the bus is ready, its capabilities are tested in the designated inspection yard. The project site also includes a repair workshop, a secondary power station, a refrigeration equipment room, a fuel station, in addition to the administrative building and some other facilities.

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Judicial fees payment made simple

Bahrain continues taking huge strides towards achieving its digital transformation goals, including making accessibility to government services easier, faster and more efficient. The launch of a newly introduced "unified epayment" Service, part of a bundle of electronic judicial services, streamlines the process for settling judicial fees.

The bundle of judicial eservices is offered jointly by the Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs, and Waqf (MOJ), and the Information & eGovernment Authority (iGA). It allows stakeholders, including lawyers and individuals, to settle due amounts related to lawsuits quickly and easily from the comfort of their offices or homes.

The unified ePayment service can be

accessed via the National Portal, bahrain.bh, where all judicial services are available. After securely logging on using an eKey, users can view their fees, select the transactions they wish to settle, and complete the process in a few clicks. There is also an option to pay all fees at once in one transaction. A receipt will be provided at the end of the process.

HUMAN RESOURCES 4.0

Personnel administration, which emerged as a clearly defined field by the 1960s in Bahrain, was largely concerned the technical aspects of hiring, evaluating, training, and compensating employees and was very much of "staff" function in most organizations. However it has developed to become modern HR function and moving towards future of HR 4.0.

The concept of HR 4.0 is closely linked to the so-called Industry 4.0, or to the fourth major industrial revolution.

If Industry 4.0 represents a major transformation in the way companies approach manufacturing, it is also true that this move has reduced human resource requirements, especially through automation. Similarly, the exchange of data between different systems has dramatically increased efficiency and decisionmaking processes related to people management.

Although the world will see even greater changes in the coming

years, much of the technology needed is already in place to replace much of the current HR-related activities.

Therefore, we can say that HR 4.0 is a revolution in the area of Human Resources. In it, HR becomes more automated, focusing its activities on strategic issues and no longer on manual, bureaucratic and repetitive actions.

This movement is seen both in the creation of tools by the IT industry and in the new demands of the government with respect to labor relations. The emergence of obligations such as eSocial, for example, has pushed HR departments to push technology into routines that were rarely done with paper documents- remember? The differences between

traditional HR and HR 4.0

In practice, it means that, unlike traditional HR where the main functions of the professionals were to pay for salaries, control of work hours and basically manual and bureaucratic activities – HR 4.0 is focused on fronts such as attracting qualified talents, improved organizational climate, and other approaches that directly contribute to the company's strategic results.

HR 4.0 is essentially permeated by technology and is in line with new labor market scenarios – with special influence from the Millennial Generation, which now reaches leading positions in organizations, and the others that have followed.
