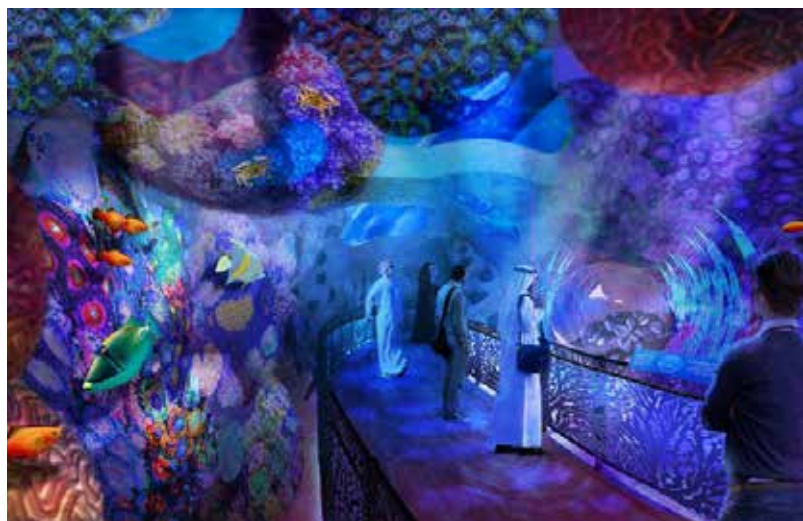

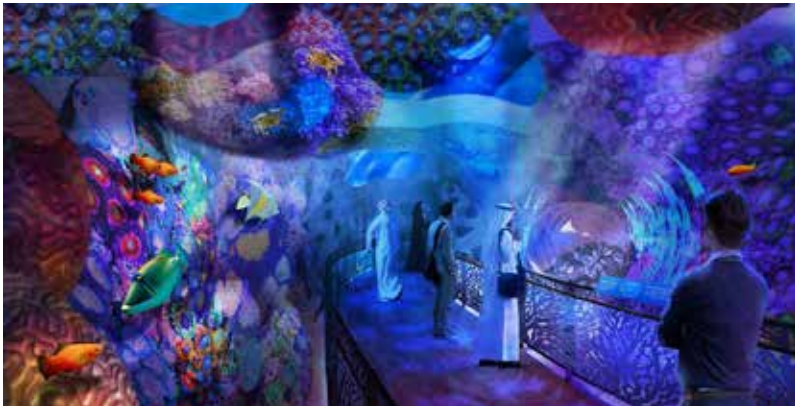

Environmental issues take centre stage at several pavilions in Expo 2020 Dubai



Visitors at Expo 2020 can embark on a curated sustainability-based journey to discover how different nations worldwide are emerging as 'Waste Warriors'.

Dynamic environmental initiatives like vertical farming to biodegradable alternatives and sipping coffee from edible cups to converting food waste into gourmet food, Expo 2020 participants are leading the way to a more sustainable planet.

Therefore, environmental concerns and their potential solutions are being addressed as part of the Expo Live Impact Series, which will take place during the Climate and Biodiversity Week – the event's first themed week.

The Climate and Biodiversity Week,

which started from October 3-9, will brought together experts and innovators from across the globe for a series of panel discussions, tackling everything from carbon footprints and single-use plastics to clean energy adoption and recycling.

Many countries' pavilions across the Expo site highlight their pioneering efforts to battle overconsumption, overproduction, and sustainable management of resources.

Visitors to the Bulgaria Pavilion can sample coffee from edible cups and see the innovation of biodegradable

Finland is making waves with its vertical farming system and zero waste agricultural technologies, based on the principles of circular economy, which will be showcased at the Nordic nation's pavilion.

The Bangladesh Pavilion demonstrates how its ban on single-use plastics paved the way for seeking newer biodegradable alternatives in different fields.

The Comoros Pavilion is highlighting its journey into a sustainable future through effective recycling of plastics and other waste materials.

Speakers and collaborators from across the world will present case studies and real-life experiences to help uncover solutions to the biggest environmental issues.

The self-guided tour on the Expo 2020 app is designed to change behaviours to mitigate our impact on our world.

The 'People for Planet' journey, available on the app, will introduce visitors to the different ways countries and organisations are responding to the key issues we face as a global community.

At the Slovenia Pavilion, visitors learn how to become part of the solution in the areas of equitable development, nature conservation and technological advances.

The net-zero energy, rainforest-inspired Singapore Pavilion explores our journey towards livability and resilience in a

pavilion whose self-sustaining ecosystem encourages people to foster stronger relationships between nature and the built environment.

The New Zealand Pavilion empowers visitors to experience a true reflection of the Maori value of 'kaitiakitanga' (guardianship of the land) as they explore the oneness of people and the environment.

Dubai is hoping to attract millions of visitors in a boost to its profile and standing during the six-month fair.



Bahrain ranks second globally in COVID Recovery Index



Bahrain is the world's second-best country on the latest edition of Nikkei's COVID-19 Recovery Index for September, as the Kingdom continues to rise in the rankings, marking great improvements and consolidating its achievements in confronting the pandemic and returning to a normal way of life.

The index assesses 121 countries and regions in terms of COVID recovery by calculating a score between 0 and 90 based on nine factors divided into three categories: infection management,

vaccine rollouts, and mobility. The higher the ranking, the closer a country is to recovery -- with low infections, higher inoculation rates and less-strict social distancing measures.

Bahrain scored 72%, only one point behind Malta, the top scorer, ahead of the United Arab Emirates (71%) and Saudi Arabia (70.5%).

According to Nickel, the methodology for the latest ranking was adjusted to reflect vaccination progress worldwide.

Instead of looking at the share of people who have received at least one

dose, we are now grading countries and regions based on the share of people who have been fully vaccinated with two shots, as one of the subcategories for vaccinations.

This adjustment only marginally changed the scores, so the results remain comparable with previous rankings.

The score is the sum of three constituent categories and nine subcategories. Each subcategory has a

maximum score of 10.

Infection management includes confirmed cases of COVID-19 versus peak case count, confirmed cases per capita and tests per case.

Vaccine rollouts cover total vaccine doses given per capita, new vaccine doses given per capita, and share of people who have been fully vaccinated.

Mobility deals with community mobility, Oxford stringency index, and flight activities.

ALMABARRAH ALKHALIFIA FOUNDATION SIGNS AN MOU WITH NASSER VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER

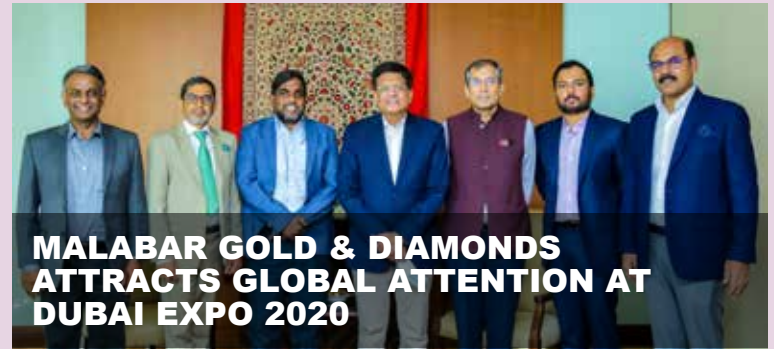

Register for Your Booster Shot Easily via BeAware Bahrain



Despite the Kingdom's gradual return to normalcy, our fight against the pandemic continues. We must all adhere to precautionary measures set by the National Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19), which were the driving force behind Bahrain's success in overcoming the challenges of this period. To do your part, register for your vaccine or booster shot via the BeAware Bahrain app, developed by the Information & eGovernment Authority (iGA) in support of the National task force to combat the spread of the coronavirus.

If you are registered on the app and eligible for a booster shot, your green shield will turn yellow. Once you receive the dose, it will revert to green. These shots have been approved for people aged 18 years or older who have received their second Pfizer-BioNTech, AstraZeneca, or Sputnik V doses at least six months ago.

To do that, download the BeAware Bahrain app from bahrain.bh/apps, choose "Registration for Coronavirus Vaccine" from the eServices, then select the required dose and vaccine. You will receive a SMS with the date of your shoot once its set by the concern authorities.

The BeAware Bahrain app also offers several other eServices including accessing PCR test results, issuance of recovery certificates, reporting of issues with health records, and more. Alternatively, you can register for a vaccine or booster shot via healthalert.gov.bh.
